

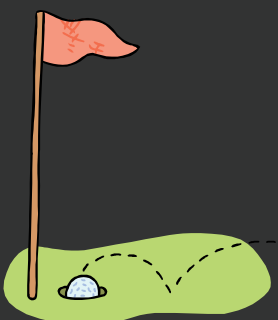

Turf Preparations for the 2010 Amateur

I am sure all of our members have noticed the new look that our course is sporting. At my first meeting with Susan White, BCGA Tournament Director, in 2009 she asked us to narrow up our landing areas and give them a more pronounced contour starting in the spring of 2010 and continuing this practice for the preparation of the 2010 Amateur. On May 14/2010 I again had an opportunity to tour every hole and discuss changes that both Susan White and Jack Croucher, BCGA Director of Course Setup, instructed me to under take in preparation for the Amateur. They were satisfied with the narrowing and contouring of the landing areas but wanted the secondary cut to be brought up from our regular 1.5" to a height of 2". They then wished to have a 1.5" collar cut between the green's apron, green side bunkers and the 2" surrounds. Also, for the tournament, holes #5 and #13 will be changed from their regular par of 5 to a par of 4 during the competition. At this time we are 7 weeks from the start of the event and have implemented all the necessary changes that will take us into the week of play for the BC Amateur Championship. I would like to thank our members for their cooperation and understanding at having to play their Golf Course set up to challenge the very best amateur golfers that British Columbia can produce.
